COVID RESPONSE UPDATE: OCTOBER 16 TH , 2020

DANBURY ARENA IS CONTINUING TO OPERATE, BUT WE ARE TEMPORARILY HALTING ALLOWING VISITORS, GUESTS, OBSERVERS, PARENTS, OR GUARDIANS FROM ENTERING THE ARENA.

OUR CURRENT SCHEDULE OF CLINICS, LESSONS, TEAM PRACTICES AND GAMES CONTINUE AS NORMAL, JUST WITHOUT OBSERVERS, PARENTS, AND NON-ESSENTIAL STAFF.

FOR THOSE WISHING TO VIEW ON-ICE GAMES, THE ARENA IS WORKING TO RESTORE OUR LIVE BARN CONNECTION.

IF A YOUTH SKATER OR PLAYER NEEDS ASSISTANCE GETTING READY, A SINGLE PARENT OR GUARDIAN MAY ENTER WITH THE PARTICIPANT TO ASSIST IN GETTING READY. ONCE FINISHED, THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN MUST LEAVE THE BUILDING AND MAY RETURN AFTER THE PLAYER GETS OFF ICE.

WHY ARE WE TAKING THIS ACTION?

On October 15th , the governor of Connecticut issued a red alert advisory for the state, naming 11 communities as part of that alert. Danbury, being the highest alert level of the list.

Danbury Arena takes your safety seriously, and that of all our players, skater, staff and the community as a whole.

In response to the current advisory, in coordination with local health authorities, Danbury Arena is halting admission of any guests, visitors, ticket holders or non-essential team staff.

All public skates, open skates and similar general public events will also be suspended for the time being.

Ticket holders will be refunded.

Danbury Arena is taking this step voluntarily, out of the greatest level of caution and care for everyone. This change in operations will continue until October 23rd, at which time the arena will re-evaluate the situation.
